1. The world has not Changed — Rom. 3:10-12
Mt. 7:13 — Ephesians 2:1 — John 3:18
2. God has not changed — Luke 19:10
Malachi 3:6 — Jn 3:16 — Lu 15 — Hebrews 13:8 — 2 Peter 3:9
3. The Power of the Gospel has not Changed — Romanos 1:16
4. God's Command has not changed — Mark 16:15
